



Open the Door to the Louisville Affordable Housing Trust Fund!

Established by Metro Council in 2008, the Affordable Housing Trust Fund is intended to invest public funds in the kind of housing our community needs: housing for people on fixed incomes like seniors and people with serious disabilities; for young families starting out; for veterans; and for working people whose wages are not enough to live in Metro Louisville.


Unfortunately, the Affordable Housing Trust Fund is lacking the crucial component necessary to provide the housing relief our communities need: dedicated revenue sufficient to meet our housing challenge.

We have a solution! Metro Council can take action *now* to help hardworking families by enacting a 1% insurance premium tax increase as the source of ongoing dedicated public revenue for the LAHTF. By doing so, Louisville establishes \$9.7 million annually in dedicated public revenue for the LAHTF to help struggling families. For the average person paying homeowner's and auto insurance in Louisville, the impact is equal to 63¢ a month for each, about the cost of a 2-liter of soda. That is not much to pay to make sure children, seniors and veterans have a place to call home. Increasing the insurance premium not only allows the Affordable Housing Trust Fund to provide needed housing, it is a job creator and a money magnet!
