

# ECONOMIC WINS

Creating quality jobs with good wages to support a family is a priority for Mayor Greg Fischer and his team.

Accomplishments include:

**47,500** jobs added to Louisville since Mayor Fischer took office in January 2011

**1,900** new businesses added since January 2011
